
GETTING STARTED with DECODABLES

Decodable readers and big books to use with your students.




DECODABLE READER

With a color and black & white version, use this reader to work with your students in small groups or one-on-one. These readers can also be printed and put in your reading center or sent home with each student.



DECODABLE READER WITH HIGHLIGHTED CVCE WORDS

With this specialized copy of the decodable reader, the decodable CVCe words are in black, making them stand out to students who might benefit from having them highlighted. This reader comes in color and black & white.




BIG BOOK READER

With both color and black & white versions, use this big book reader as your "teacher copy" of the book. Use in your small groups or display on the smartboard.



BIG BOOK READER WITH HIGHLIGHTED CVCE WORDS

Use this big book if you are using the student reader with the highlighted words, so your book can also emphasize the word family words.


WORD CARDS

Add one of these word cards to your decodable readers to give students an extra chance to practice reading the words from the story.




FLUENCY PRACTICE

COMPREHENSION QUESTIONS

With a multiple choice or short answer option, these comprehension questions are perfect to add onto your reader copies.



ACTIVITY PAGES

Students can complete a "Match it Up" activity where they read the sentence and draw a line to the corresponding picture. Additionally, students can complete the "Say it, Build it, Write it" activity to practice spelling the decodable words.

FULL-PAGE ACTIVITIES

Use these activities and resources after reading or in a center. Students can practice different skills including fluency, segmenting, comprehension, and more.




REVIEW PAGE

Use the review page after reading or as review later in the week for your students to practice reading and spelling the word family words.




WORD CARDS

If you're looking for an interactive, hands-on activity for your students to engage in after reading the decodable reader, the full-page version of "Say It, Build It, Write It" has them cut & paste letters to physically build the decodable words. The horizontal version is an alternate, non-cut & paste option.




COMPREHENSION PAGES

Each comprehension page starts with the full decodable passage, followed by either multiple choice questions, short answer questions, or an illustration option.




WORD MAPPING MAT

Print this mat and laminate or put in a page protector to use over and over with students either in a small group or in a center. Students can use dry erase markers to graph and write the word, or manipulatives such as letter tiles.



READ AND MATCH

Use one of these three options of "Read and Match" activities where students can either draw a line to the corresponding picture to match each sentence or cut & paste the picture in the correct space.



CLIP CARDS

Laminate and cut these clip cards to put them in a center or to use as extra review after reading the decodable reader. Students can clip the matching picture/word with a clothespin or cover with manipulatives.
