These posters use real-life pictures and simple definitions that are easy for students to understand. Hang them up in your classroom or project on your smart board.




VOCABULARY CARDS

Add the new vocabulary you are introducing to your students throughout the week to your writing center, a word wall, or a pocket chart for them to refer to.


WRITING CENTER

After learning how each country celebrates Christmas, students can identify words and items associated with each countries' celebrations with these worksheets.




FACT WORKSHEETS


Throughout the units, or to culminate them, use any of these worksheet options to have students show what they've learned about Christmas in each country. Fill in the blank or cut & paste options are both available.
