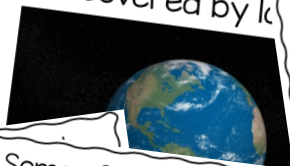




# Landform



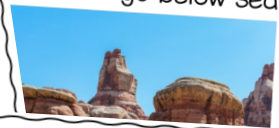
About 30% of the earth's surface is covered by land.

## SEA

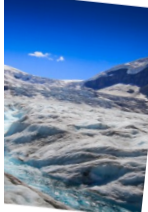


- Body of salt water

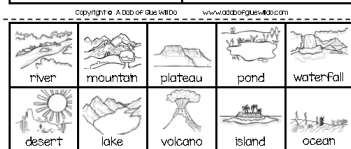

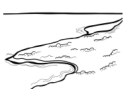

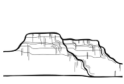
#### Peninsula

A landform that rises high above the surrounding terrain.

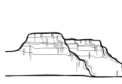
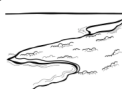


#### Plateau
