# Take a Closer Look:

**MOTHER'S DAY CARD CRAFT DIRECTIONS**  
Students can make this Fun Flower craft as a gift for their mom or another special person.

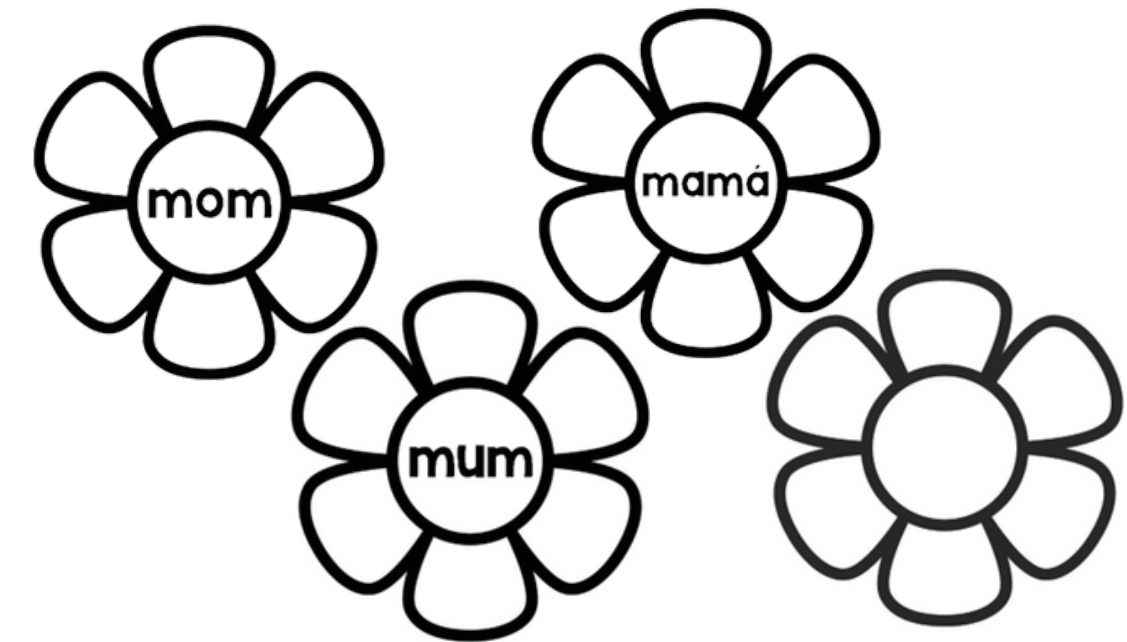
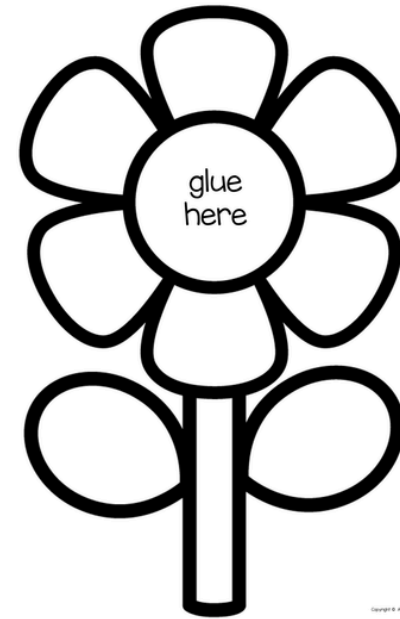
**SUPPLIES**

- copy paper
- scissors
- glue
- coloring tools

**DIRECTIONS**

- 1) Choose a Flower and Flowerpot version:
  - Flower Options: "Mom," "Mum", and editable version (Spanish version included)
  - Pot Options: "You are," "I love my mom/mum because," and editable version (Spanish versions included)
- 2) Each student will need one Flower with a stem, one Flower without a stem, and one Flowerpot.
- 3) Each student will take the Flower with a stem and write character traits that describe their special person on each petal. They can also color the stem and leaves.
- 4) Next, students will cut out and color the top Flower (no stem). This Flower will be glued onto the center of the bottom Flower so that each petal can be lifted to read the character trait underneath.
- 5) Students will draw a picture of or write about their special person on the Flowerpot, depending on the version chosen.
- 6) Students will glue the bottom of the stem onto the top of the Flowerpot. To make more secure, teacher can add tape to the back of the stem to help connect it to the pot.

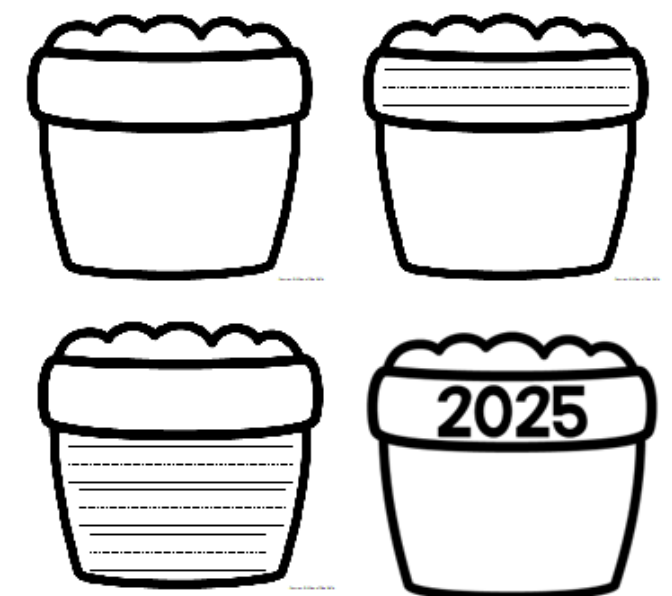
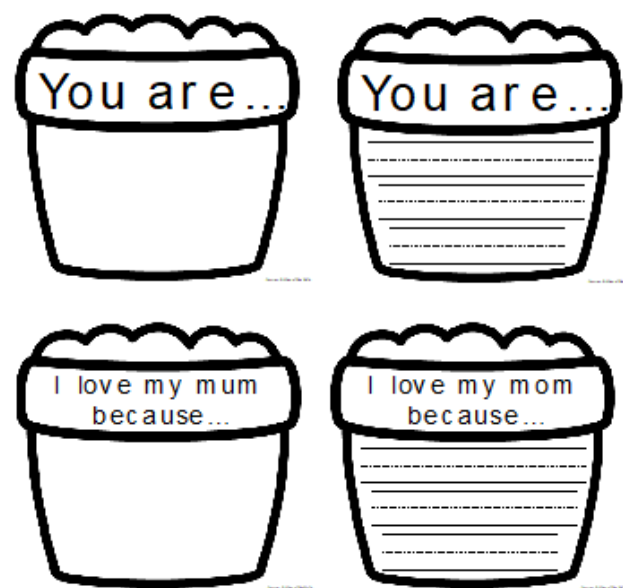
\*Optional: Students can glue the entire craft onto a large piece of construction paper to add a background.

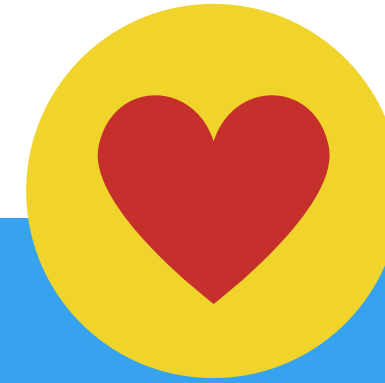

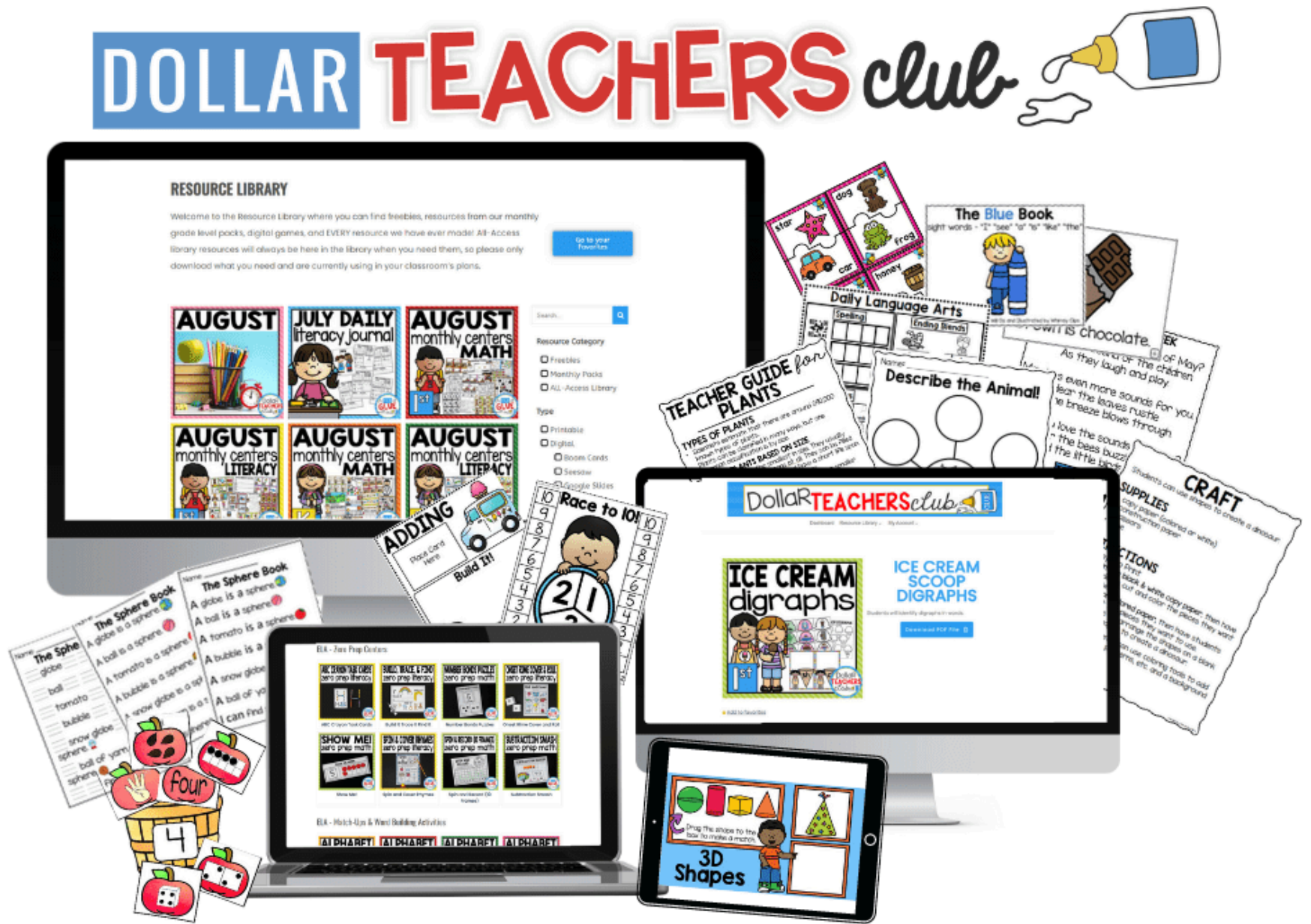

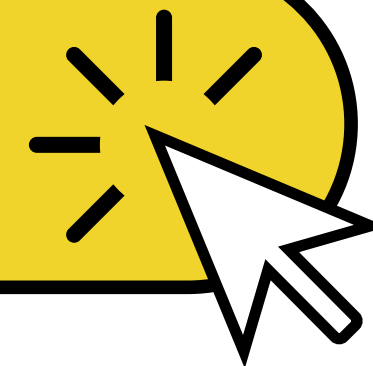
