
LESSON PLANS

Send home these notes and let families know what their children are learning about in science. This letter also includes ideas for families to extend the learning at home.




TEACHER GUIDE


FINGERPLAY

Students can practice reading and review color words with this interactive emergent reader. After reading the book in whole group, copies can be put in the reading center or sent home for extra practice.








WRITING CENTER


DEFINITION POSTERS


