# Take a Closer Look:

**TEACHER GUIDE for GOOD CITIZENSHIP**

**CITIZENS**

- A citizen is a person who is a member of a community, state, or nation.
- Citizens have rights and responsibilities. Different countries give their citizens more or different rights than other countries.
- Rights are freedoms given to people by the government that cannot be taken away, like the freedom of speech and the right to vote.
- Responsibilities are things a good citizen should do, like vote, volunteer, help people in the community, pick up after themselves, etc. People also have the responsibility of serving on a jury if they get called.
- Good citizens follow rules and laws, are responsible and respectful, and help others.

**BECOMING A CITIZEN**

- Countries have their own rules about who is a citizen and how a person can become one. A person is considered a citizen if they are born in the country, if their parents were born in the country, if they marry a citizen of the country, or if they go through a process called naturalization.
- Naturalization is how a person becomes a citizen in another country. Sometimes the naturalization process includes taking and passing a test, taking an oath, and swearing to be loyal to the country.

Not every country allows noncitizens to become naturalized citizens. Sometimes people can lose their citizenship. Some countries may take away a person's citizenship if they become a citizen of another country or if they are no longer loyal to the country. A person who has lost their citizenship and is not considered a citizen of any country is called a stateless person.

**CITIZENSHIP DAY**

Citizenship Day is on September 17th. It is also Constitution Day. The day is meant to commemorate the formation and signing of the Constitution, which occurred on September 17th, 1787, as well as reflecting on the meaning and importance of being an American citizen. The observance began in 1940 when President Franklin Roosevelt proclaimed the day as "I am an American Day." It was a day to honor people who volunteered for allegiance to the United States and had gone through naturalization. It was celebrated in May 1952, President Harry Truman signed a bill renaming the day to "Citizenship Day" and moved the day to September 17th, the same day as Constitution Day. President Truman proclaimed that the two days were merged and that every citizen born in the United States, or not, should give thought and consideration to their rights and responsibilities under the constitution on September 17th.
