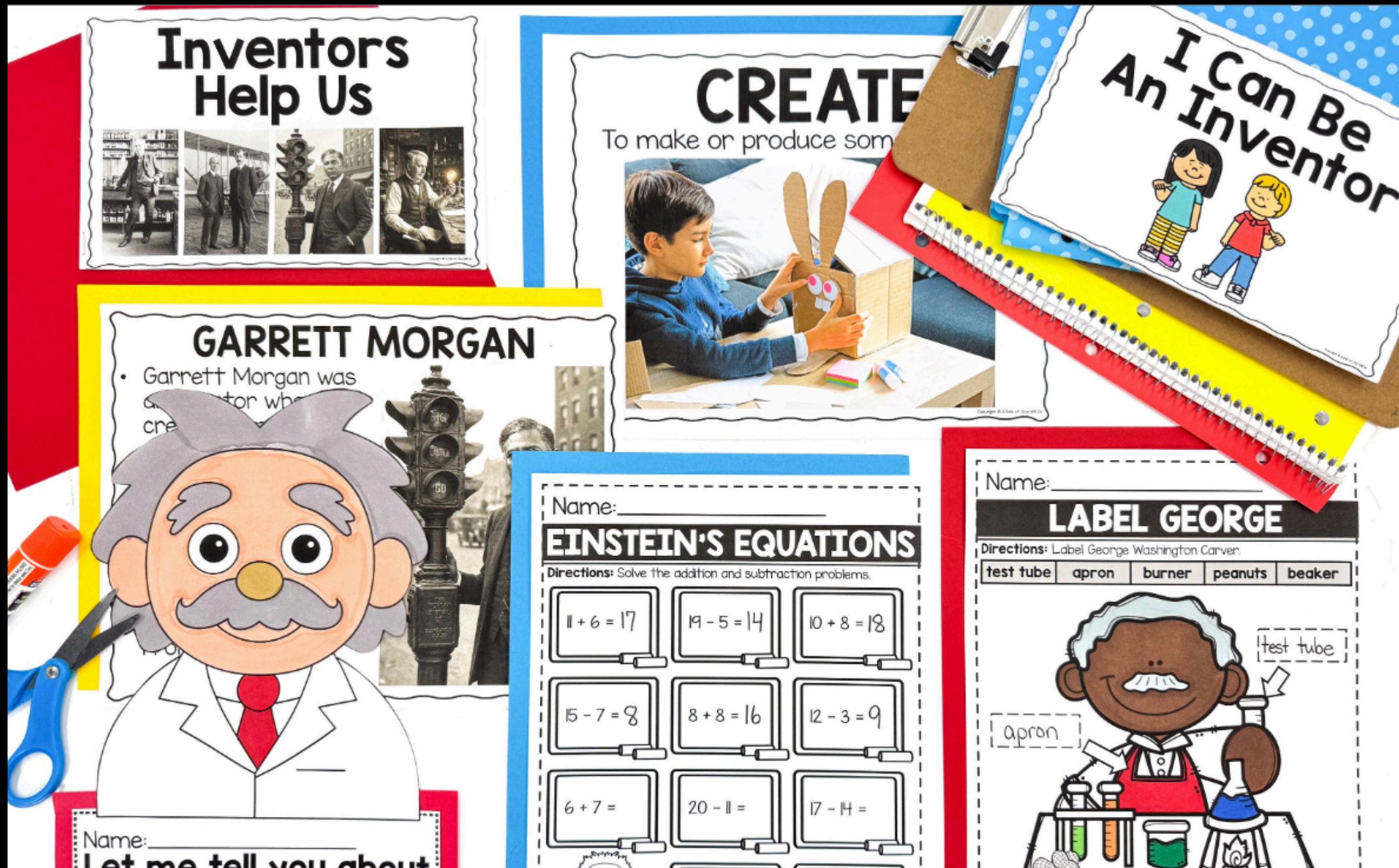

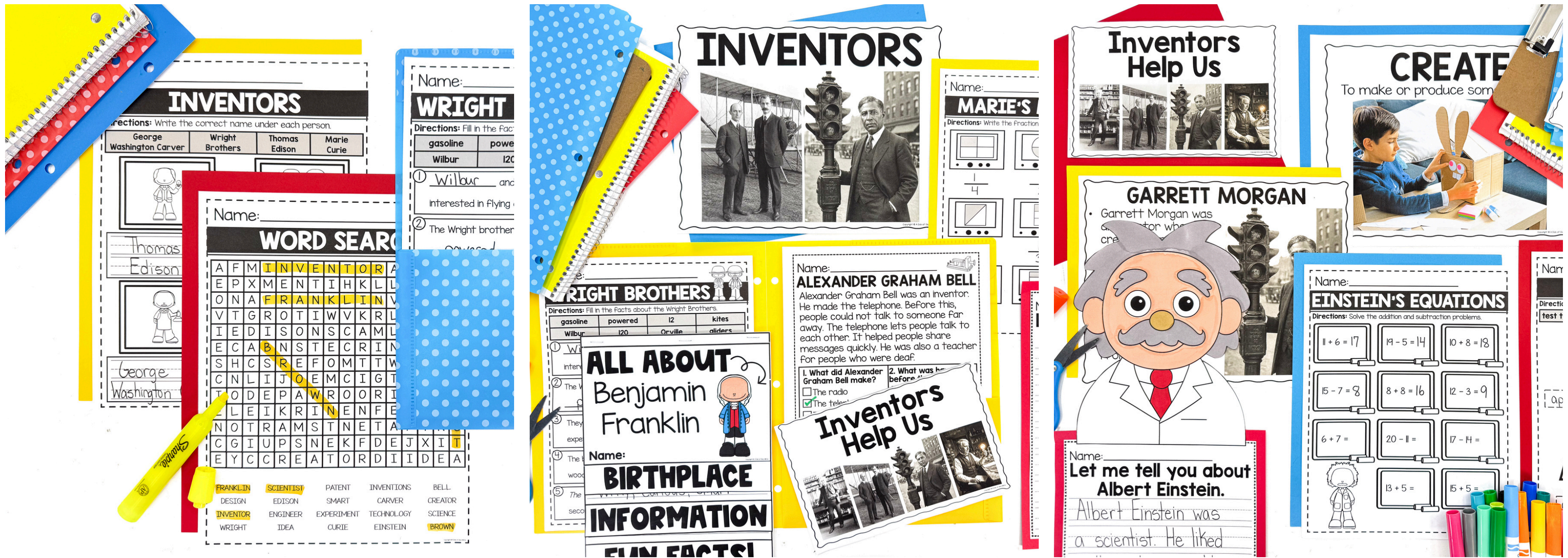



Valerie Thomas is a scientist and inventor. She worked at NASA for more than 30 years. She helped develop computer systems that turn satellite pictures into useful information. Valerie invented a special device called the illusion transmitter. This device sends 3D images that look real and seem to float. Later, she became a leader at NASA and helped students explore STEM careers.

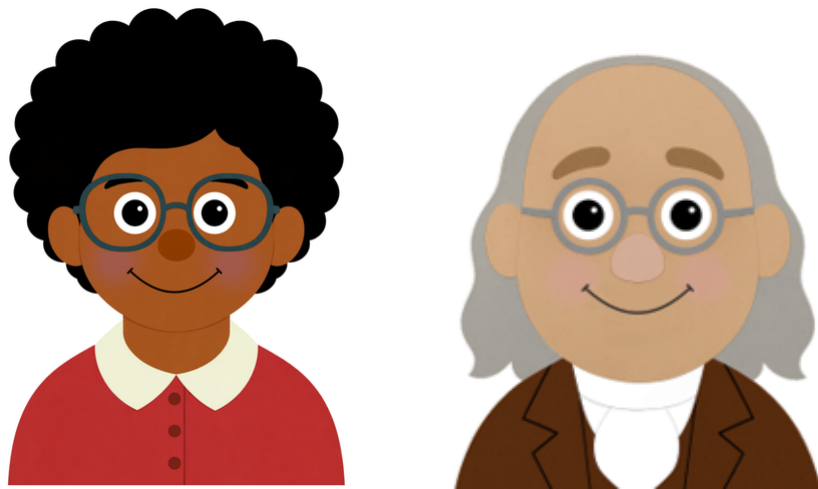

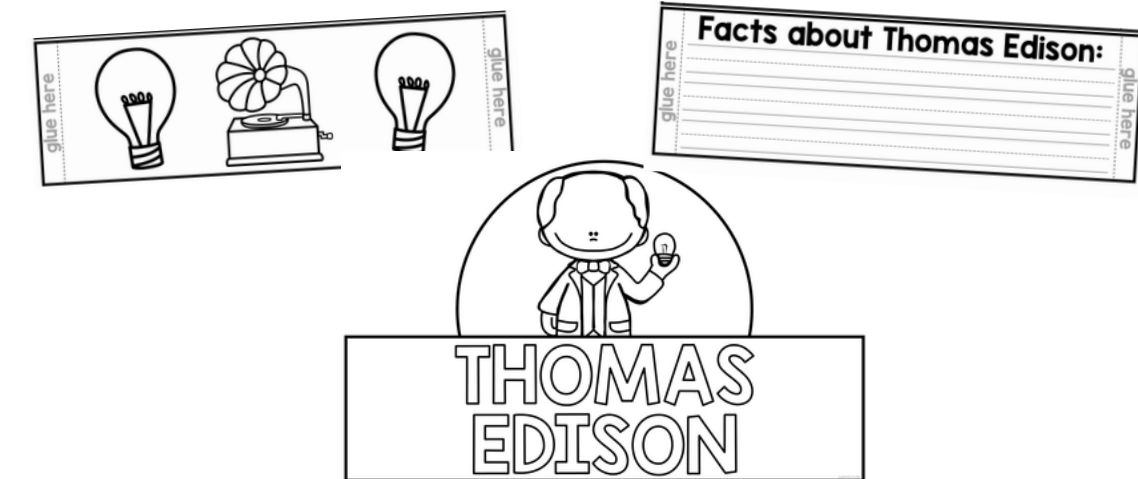

TEACHER GUIDE for INVENTORS

INVENTORS AND INVENTIONS

- An inventor is someone who notices a problem and works to create something new to help solve it. Inventors come from many different backgrounds and experiences.
- An invention is something new that did not exist before. It can be something physical, like a tool or machine, or it can be something abstract, like a new way of doing something. Inventors often create things that make people's lives easier, faster, or safer.
- Inventing is not just about big machines or people. It is about thinking, trying new ideas, and learning from mistakes.

ALBERT EINSTEIN

- Albert Einstein was a scientist who studied light, space, and time. His work helped scientists understand how things move and interact. He did not invent everyday machines, but his ideas led to many modern technologies.

ALEXANDER GRAHAM BELL

- Alexander Graham Bell invented the telephone that allows people to talk to each other from far away. He studied sound and communication, especially interested in helping people who were hard of hearing. His invention changed the way we communicate around the world.

BENJAMIN FRANKLIN

- Benjamin Franklin was an inventor, scientist, and one of the Founding Fathers of the United States. He studied electricity and is known for his kite experiment, which showed that lightning is a form of electricity. He invented the lightning rod, which helps protect buildings from lightning strikes.

GARRETT MORGAN

- Garrett Morgan was an inventor who created important safety devices. He improved the traffic light by adding a warning signal to help control traffic. He also invented a safety hood that protected people from smoke and was used by firefighters.

GEORGE WASHINGTON CARVER

- George Washington Carver was a scientist who studied plants and farming. He discovered many ways to use crops like peanuts, sweet potatoes, and soybeans. He also helped farmers learn better ways to grow crops and take care of the soil.

MARIE CURIE

- Marie Curie was a scientist who studied radioactivity, a special kind of energy. Her discoveries helped scientists learn more about atoms and led to important uses in medicine. She was the first woman to win a Nobel Prize and the first person to win two Nobel Prizes in different sciences.
