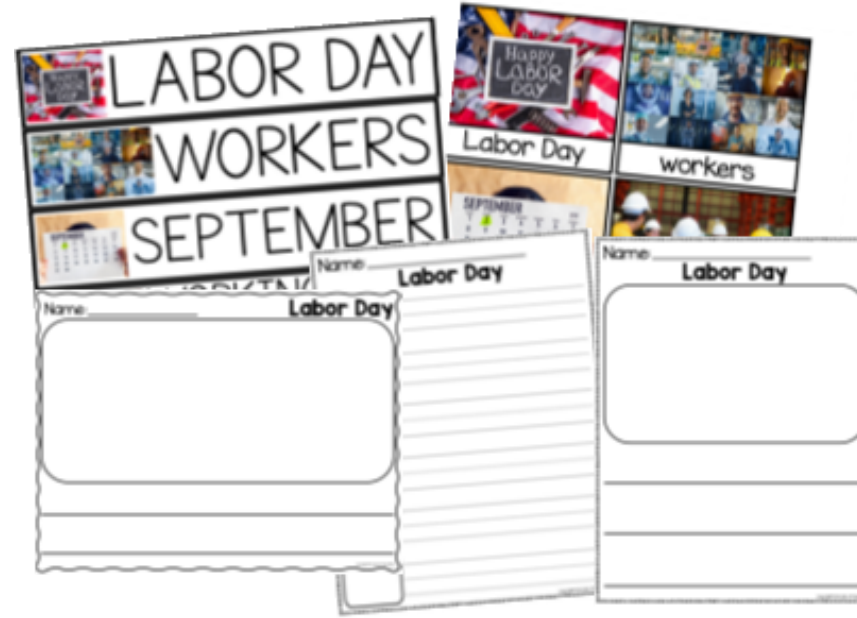
## TEACHER GUIDE for LABOR DAY

### HISTORY OF LABOR DAY

- Labor Day was first celebrated in the United States in New York City in 1882. It was proposed during a labor union meeting that a day off for the working class should be established and a parade should be held.
- On September 5<sup>th</sup>, 1882, the parade was held, with more than 10,000 marchers parading through the streets in a peaceful demonstration. The point of the demonstration was to show their unity and desire for fair working conditions.
- The march led to efforts to establish a national holiday in honor of workers. Labor unions in other cities were encouraged to hold celebrations as well. In 1894, President Grover Cleveland made Labor Day a national holiday.
- For many years, Labor Day celebrations were similar to the first one in New York. Many people would celebrate the day with family and friends after the parades.

### LABOR DAY TODAY

- Labor Day is celebrated on the first Monday in September. While big parades and marches are less common on Labor Day in the present day, many workers still get the day off, and kids are off from school. Labor Day is often seen as the unofficial end of summer. Many people gather with family or friends for picnics, barbecues, or other celebrations.

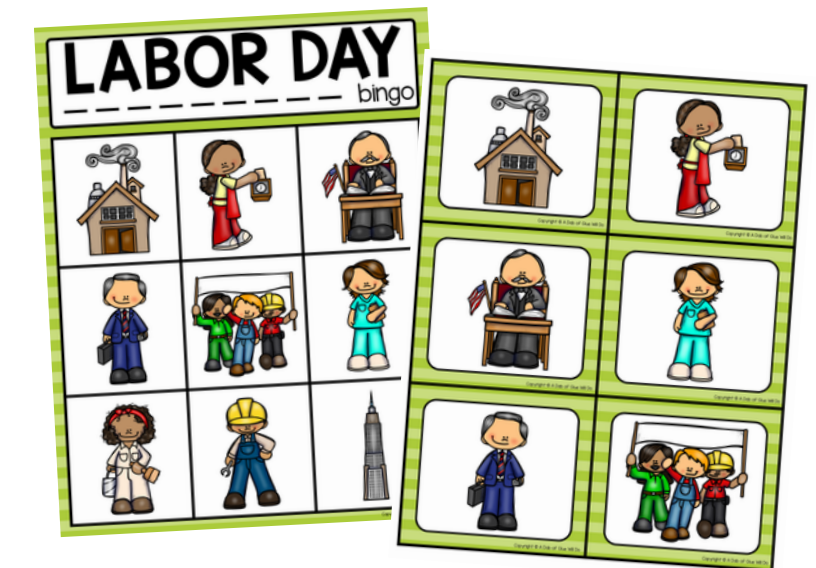



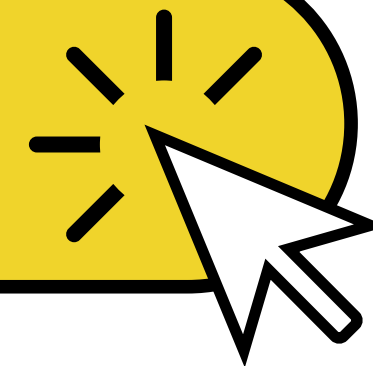
