DIRECTIONS

- I) Students will get a mat and either a dry erase marker, small manipulatives (small erasers work great), or play-do.
- 2) Students will look at the proper way to build/write a letter by looking at the tracing letter at the bottom of the mat.
- 3) Students will then model proper formation by building/tracing the open faced letter with either the marker, manipulatives, or play-do.

QUICK DIFFERENTIATION

KIDS THAT NEED A CHALLENGE:

- 1) Have students try to write the letter after they have built the letter.
- 2) Have the students try to think of another word that begins with that letter.

KIDS THAT NEED A REVIEW:

 Pull students into a small group and model how to make the letter using proper formation.
