## DIRECTIONS

I) This game is a partner game. Play with 2 different colored counters.
2) One student will pick a card.
3) They will read the word on the card.
4) Students will then cover the matching picture on the mat with a counter.
5) Their partner will then go.

2) Give students an alphabet chart to help identify the sounds the letters make.
