DIRECTIONS

- 1) Teacher will need to fold the card backwards on the dotted line to hide the picture.
- 2) Students will tap the dots as they make each sound the letter above it makes.
- 3) Students will then slide their finger across the arrow to blend the sounds together to read the word.
- 4) Students will flip over the folded part to check themselves.




KIDS THAT NEED A REVIEW:
