#### **DIRECTIONS**

- Students will flip card and say the name of the picture.
- 2) Students will then cover a picture on their mat that rhymes with the picture on the card.
- 3) Student wins when they cover 4 in a row on their mat.

#### QUICK DIFFERENTIATION

#### KIDS THAT NEED A CHALLENGE:

 Students can write each rhyming pair words out to notice how the ending is the same.

#### KIDS THAT NEED A REVIEW:

I) Pull the kids who struggle into a small group and model saying each word, separating the beginning sound from the ending rhyming chunk. Emphasize the rhyming chunk so they can hear the rhyme.

Flip a card. Cover a picture that rhymes with it.



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
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
