## DIRECTIONS

I) Students will need a pocket chart to sort.
2) Students will place the 2 topic cards at the top of the pocket chart.
3) Students will then sort the letter/words cards in the appropriate spots.

## QUICK DIFFERENTIATION

## KIDS THAT NEED A CHALLENGE:

I) Students can generate a words that starts with the letter they sort.
2) Students can try say a sentence using the word that they sorted.

## KIDS THAT NEED A REVIEW:

I) Pull students up to a small group and emphasize that letters make one sound but a word has multiple sounds/letters and can be used in a sentence.
2) You can make these strips self checking, by adding marks on the back of the sorting cards.
