DIRECTIONS

- I) Teacher will need to cut along center lines to create the puzzles.
- 2) Students will put the puzzles together.
- 3) Students will segment the phonemes as they put the pictures together. (There are the same number of puzzle pieces for each phoneme in the word.)
- 4) Students can then blend the phonemes to create the word.






1) Pull students up to a small group and have students tap each puzzle piece as they say the sounds.









